

Night Navigation Circuit #2 – Penwyllt

Overview: Another spot with easy access and a good range of features in the nearby terrain. The gritstone outcrops on the top of the hill present one of the hardest spots to navigate in South Wales, a great test of navigational skill. This course eases you in gently, but will really challenge you in the second half. This circuit is designed to take an evening to complete, but be flexible and add./remove legs as required, there's lots of potential for learning at this spot, and you can always return another night...

Starting Point: (SN 856 155) Follow the lane from the valley road (A4067) up to the end of the tarmac, then continue along the track past the quarry towards the Caving Club. Park in the large carpark by the quarry.

The Circuit:

Point 1- (859 156) Step-through style.

Point 2- (859 157) Ring contour feature.

Point 3- (860 161) Grassy spur.

Point 4- (863 156) Cave entrance (small metal hatch down steps).

Point 5- (865 154) Ring contour feature.

Point 6- (859 152) Large shake hole.
